

DAUPHIN COUNTY TECHNICAL SCHOOL
Admissions Policy Summary

Any student who resides within Central Dauphin, Derry Township, Halifax Area, Lower Dauphin, Middletown Area, and Susquehanna Township school districts, and who will be promoted to the ninth grade or above may apply to attend Dauphin County Technical School (DCTS). DCTS admits students without regard to an applicant's race, color, national origin, sex or disability.

In September and October of each year, application forms will be distributed to the participating school districts' counselors by the DCTS counselors. Following a school district visitation and orientation by a DCTS counselor and student ambassadors, interested students may receive application forms from their district counselors.

The Dauphin County Technical School has an open admissions policy in effect for career and technical education (CTE) programs in which there are sufficient openings available in order for all students who apply to be accepted. For those programs or participating school districts that have limited annual openings, students will be considered for admission based on the eligibility criteria listed on the following pages. These criteria will help to predict an applicant's ability to succeed in a vocational/technical program at Dauphin County Technical School.

Criteria

1. Aptitude Assessment
2. Student Interest
3. Behavior
4. Attendance
5. Grades

This admissions policy will be summarized and published in October of each year. It will also be translated into a foreign language, when necessary, for students with limited English proficiency.
